Today, nursery care is available for the entire 10:00 worship service.

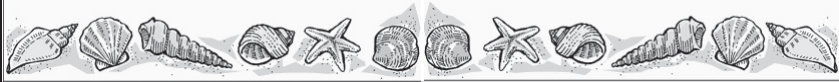
Children in preschool – grade 2 can leave for children's church following the children's moment. Children in grades 3 and above should stay with their parents for the worship service.

As of June 27th, Children's Ministries will switch to our summer schedule:

At CCEG: nursery and preschool will be offered during the 8:30 and 10:00 services. There will not be childcare offered during the 11:30 service.

Children in grades K and above are welcome to stay with their parents for the worship service, though please note that if you need to take time out with them, the Community Room is available where you can hear and view the service.

At CCNK: During the 9:00 service, nursery will be available for the entire hour, as it is now. Children's church for preschool – grade 2 will be held following the children's moment. Children in grades 3 and above should stay with their parents for the worship service.

**Connect to God each week:**

There is also a **Sunday evening** service at 6:30pm called "Sanctuary." This is a Jesus community bent on working out what it means to love God and love our neighbors.

On **Tuesday Evenings** we hold a smaller, more meditative service of prayer, worship, healing and communion at 7:00pm in our church sanctuary.

Sunday Mornings we will resume services in **East Greenwich** next week at 8:30am, 10:00am & 11:30am. The adult sermon discussion group will continue to meet at the office Condo at 10:00am throughout the summer. All are welcome. Sunday Morning Service at **North Kingstown High School** will begin at 9:00am throughout the summer.
