## Connect to God:

Every **Sunday morning** we have services at two locations, our church in East Greenwich - CCEG (1025 Main St.), where we hold 3 consecutive services (8:30am, 10:00am & 11:30am) and one at North Kingstown High School - CCNK (150 Fairway Dr.) at 9:00am.

For the summer:

**At CCEG:** nursery and preschool will be offered during the 8:30 and 10:00 services. There will be no childcare offered during the 11:30 service. Children in grades K and above are welcome to stay with their parents for the worship service, though please note that if you need to take time out with them, the Community Room is available where you can hear and view the service.

**At CCNK:** During the 9:00 service, nursery will be available for the entire hour, as it is now. Children's church for preschool - grade 2 will be held following the children's moment. Children in grades 3 and above should stay with their parents for the worship service.

There is also a **Sunday evening** service at 6:30pm called "Sanctuary." This is a Jesus community bent on working out what it means to love God and love our neighbors.

On **Tuesday Evenings** we hold a smaller, more meditative service of prayer, worship, healing and communion at 7:00pm in our church sanctuary.
